¹ This is a 3-2 program where students take physics and general education courses at Loyola during their first three years and then pursue an engineering degree at another university for an additional two years. With the successful completion of the engineering degree, the student transfers those courses back to Loyola and earns a B.S. in physics-pre-engineering degree. The amount of transferred credit will bring the total to a minimum of 120 semester hours. Loyola coordinates this program with the University of New Orleans and Tulane University. However, they may also enroll at another university that has an accredited engineering program.

² The LL.M is not a typical graduate program. It is considered a graduate professional program offered through the College of Law and is different from other graduate programs. Upon approval by the College of Law, their research proved that 24 hours is standard for this type of program. The sequence for the program is different from other graduate programs. Typically, a students receives their undergraduate degree, followed by their doctorate (J.D.) and then the masters (LL.M.) For purposes of academic appointment and tenure, J.D. degree is considered a terminal degree in the American legal education.
