Multiple Examination Policy: The maximum number of examinations which a student is required to take on any one day during the final examination period is two. Students with more than two scheduled exams may seek exception to the schedule as follows:

1. the student takes the same exam at a time when the same professor has a scheduled exam for a different section of the same course, or failing that,
2. the student requests each professor that he or she voluntarily reschedule the student's exam within the exam period, or failing that,
3. the professor with the middle exam administers the exam to that student at some other time during the exam period.
