The Annual Report Application is designed to improve the format standardization, consistency of generation and completion of Annual reports for all Colleges and Departments for the University Community.

Overview:

The Annual Report application is constructed of two parts, User/Department and Administrative Functions. The user/Department functions accessed by individual Colleges and Departments are designed to improve the consistency of information for each section of the annual reports. The status display is used to track the completion progress of each section and overall report. The generation function extracts and formats a publishable PDF Annual Report document. The Administrative functions of the application are designed to standardize the Annual Report format, track the status of each user/departments progress and extract information at the University level.

Features:

- WEB based

- User and Administrative security

- Database storage of data and backup processing

- Historical multi-year processing

- Standardized formatting of Annual Report sections

- Administrative mining tool for extracting and merging sections across departments

- PDF generation tool for publication of reports

- Built-in word processor for editing of text and section data

- Administrative monitoring tool to track activity and progress by Colleges and Departments
