Includes those on sabbatical leave and replacements for instructional faculty on leave without pay and Clinic Faculty. Excludes faculty on leave without pay and replacements for instructional faculty on sabbatical leave. Excludes teaching assistants and teaching fellows. Excludes administrative officers such as dean of students, librarian, registrar, coach, etc. whose major regular assignment is not instruction. (Based on AAUP Definition)
- Also includes faculty who are an a buyout, phased retirement or reduction in force who are teaching in the Fall semester.
- ** Non-Instructional Faculty: Includes those faculty who are on leave without pay, phased retirement, and buyouts for those faculty not teaching in the Fall semester. This is a holding category.
- *** Administrative Faculty: Includes faculty whose major regular assignment is not instruction (assoc. provosts, deans, assoc. deans, etc.)
