Scope:

1. This Committee is the central organization to oversee program matters of the undergraduate colleges and the Graduate Division of the University.
2. It shall study and approve or disapprove all proposals for addition, elimination, or modification of program offerings in the undergraduate colleges and the Graduate Division.
3. It shall, if necessary, recommend modifications or changes to, or elimination of, various portions of the proposals that come before it for approval, and send them back to Dean for revision and re- submissions.
4. Committee members shall coordinate with the Vice Provost's Office and the Registrar's Office the implementation of any new course and/or course changes adopted by the respective colleges.
5. Committee members shall inform the Committee of those changes for documentation and tracking purposes.
6. It shall meet on a monthly basis during the academic year, or more often at the call of the Chair.
7. It shall report to the Provost and Senior Vice President for Academic Affairs.
